APSI Fee Waivers

Seeking to increase and strengthen quality services available to Montana's high ability/high potential and high achieving students, the Montana RESA Network* will offer fee waivers for this institute in the amount of \$250 (half the cost of APSI tuition). To apply for this fee waiver, Montana teachers must submit an application via email to director@WMPLC by noon on April 20, 2018, with the following:

- Applicant Teacher Name, High School, email address, telephone number, AP® Course in which the applicant teacher will participate
- One-paragraph statement from school administrator (Superintendent, Principal, or Assistant Principal) regarding the high school's commitment to challenging coursework for high ability/high potential and high achieving students, including Advanced Placement®.
- One-paragraph statement from the teacher who will attend the APSI stating what the value of this workshop will be to his/her teaching and to his/her students.
- Brief summary of the AP® experience of the teacher who will attend the APSI (Note: scholarships may be awarded to educators with or without AP teaching experience).
- Brief statement of need – why do this teacher and high school need support for this institute?
- Statement of commitment that if awarded a scholarship, the Applicant Teacher agrees to register for the 2018 Montana Advanced Placement Summer Institute by April 25, 2018.

April 25 ▪ Deadline for successful applicants to register for 2018 APSI

Criteria

Applications will be evaluated based on demonstrated:

- commitment to teaching and learning through Advanced Placement and
- need for support to attend institute.

The RESA Network places a priority to award fee waivers to high schools of all sizes throughout the state of Montana.
